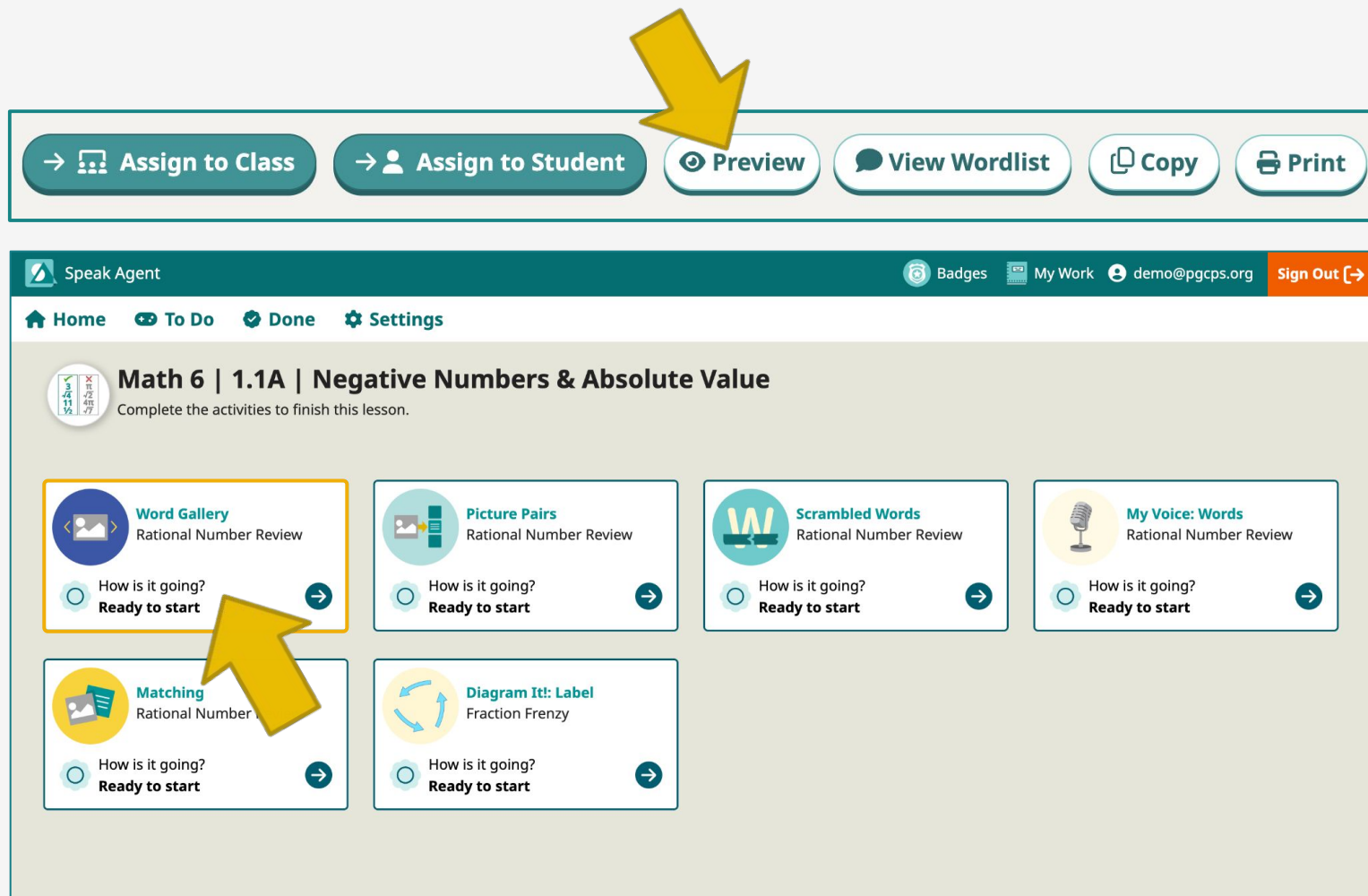

Acquire Vocabulary. Part A of each lesson set engages students in listening, speaking, decoding, and morphology practice using visual aids. Our goal is to make the academic concepts accessible to all learners.

Build Comprehension. Part B of each lesson engages students in reading and interacting with simplified but age-appropriate texts that apply the key concepts and related vocabulary. Our goal in Part B is to deepen a student's understanding of the key academic concepts and make real-world connections.

Communicate Reasoning. The final part of each lesson, which may be part B or C, depending on your course, also provides opportunities for more open-ended expression. Our goal with this is to encourage students to demonstrate mastery of the concepts and to show their thought process.
